

Directions to NIH

From the Metrorail

Take Metro's Red Line to the Medical Center Station. When you exit the station's escalators, the NIH Gateway Center (Building 66) will be directly ahead of you. Proceed to the Gateway Center, which is open for pedestrians Monday – Friday, 6am – 10pm.


Driving

From Baltimore and All Points North of Washington DC Take I-95 south toward Washington, DC. At I-495 (Capital Beltway), head west toward Silver Spring/Bethesda. From the Beltway (I-495), take Exit 34, which is Rt. 355 (Wisconsin Ave./Rockville Pike) and head south toward Washington/Bethesda. Follow signs to the Main Visitor's entrance on the right at NIH Gateway Drive (you will pass South Drive).

From I-495 (Capital Beltway) in Northern Virginia

Take I-495 (Capital Beltway) westbound (Outer Loop) or northbound (Inner Loop). Take Exit 36 to Old Georgetown Road, south. Turn left onto West Cedar Lane. Turn right onto Rockville Pike. Follow signs to the Main Visitor's entrance on the right at NIH Gateway Drive (you will pass South Drive).

Visitor Entrance




Visitor Parking

Parking is at the Gateway Parking Garage (MLP-11):
 Monday – Friday:
 6am – 9pm (entrance)
 6am – 11pm (exit)
 \$2.00 per hour for the first three hours and \$12.00 for the entire day

Visitors parking in the Gateway Parking Garage (MLP-11) should proceed out of the Parking Garage to the Gateway Center (Bldg. 66) for a visitor badge. No vehicle inspection is required to park in MLP-11. Vehicles left in the MLP-11 parking garage after 11pm on weekdays are subject to ticketing and towing.

From the Gateway Center, Building 66 to the The John Edward Porter Neuroscience Research Center, Building 35


Shuttle Service

Immediately after exiting the Gateway Center to your right, there is a shuttle pick up and drop off area. Take the **Red line "Campus Shuttle"** bus to Building 35. The shuttle bus leaves every 15 to 20 minutes.

The [full NIH shuttle bus schedule link](#) provides the Campus Route and Shuttle times. All visitors may use the shuttle service.

Building 35

- Exit the NIH Campus Shuttle at the shuttle stop for Building 35,
- Turn left and walk to the second walkway on right.
- Turn right walk down the ramp to the ground floor entrance of Building 35 and enter the ground floor lobby. Proceed to the registration check-in and conference rooms pass the stairs on the left.



Walking Directions

- After exiting the Gateway Center, walk past the shuttle bus stops down South Drive.
- Keep straight and cross over Center Drive.
- Continue to walk straight up the hill passing Building 50 and Building 13 on your left.
- Cross over at the curve. Continue walking on the sidewalk passing the 10H parking lot and Building 49 on your left.
- At the intersection of South Drive and Convent Drive, cross over Convent Drive and make a left on to Convent Drive.
- Walk past Building 40 and the Shuttle Bus stop and turn right at the second walkway.
- Walk down the ramp to the ground floor entrance of Building 35 and enter the ground floor lobby. Proceed to the registration check-in and conference rooms pass the stairs on the left.
