Access to Health Services

Increasing access to affordable, high-quality, and convenient health care services can improve population health.

Health Insurance. Health insurance helps people reduce the amount they have to pay for health services. People with health insurance are more likely to receive or seek out routine care.

Health Worker Availability. Having more health workers in a community can help improve the availability of important preventive health services and reduce community member wait times for those services.



Telehealth. Telehealth can improve health service access for people without reliable transportation, people in rural or remote communities, and people who speak languages other than English.

Transportation. Reliable transportation to health services makes it easier to seek treatment. Mobile health units can be used to reach communities where reliable transportation is unavailable.
