Hospital Value-based Purchasing Program (HVBP)

Goals & Structure

- Congress authorized HVBP in Section 3001(a) of the [Affordable Care Act](#). The program uses the hospital quality data reporting infrastructure that was developed for the Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting (IQR) Program, authorized by Section 501(b) of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003.

GOALS:

- Promote better clinical outcomes for hospital patients, improve the patient experience of care during hospital stays, and encourage hospitals to improve the quality and safety of care that all patients receive, including eliminating or reducing the occurrence of adverse events.

STRUCTURE and SCORING:

- Value-based incentive payments are made to hospitals that meet the performance standards
- Hospitals are scored based on achievement and improvement in determining overall hospital performance

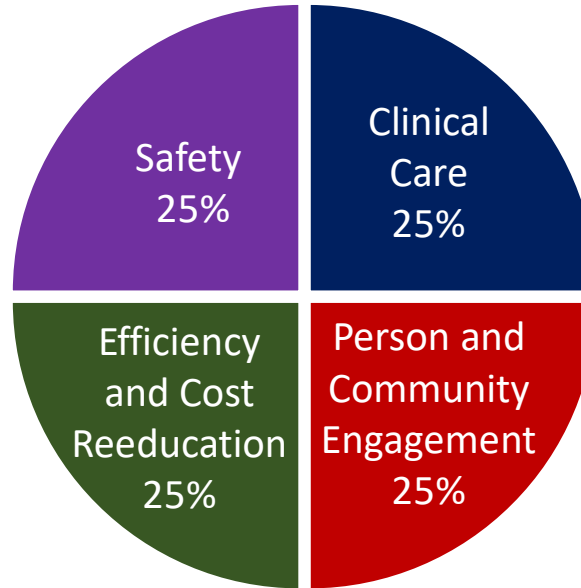
SAFETY

1. CDI: Clostridium difficile infection
2. CAUTI: Catheter-Associated Urinary tract infection
3. CLABSI: Central Line-Associated Blood Stream Infection.
4. MRSA: Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus aureus
5. SSI: Surgical Site Infection Colon Surgery & Abdominal
6. PC-01: Elective Delivery Prior to 37 Completed Weeks Gestation.

CLINICAL CARE

1. **MORT-30-AMI:** Acute Myocardial Infarction (AMI) 30-Day Mortality Rate
2. **MORT-30-HIF:** Heart Failure (HF) 30-Day Mortality Rate
3. **MORT-30-PN:** Pneumonia (PN) 30-Day Mortality Rate
4. **THA/TKA:** Elective Primary Total Hip Arthroplasty (THA) and/or Total Knee Arthroplasty (TKA) Complication Rate

Person and Community Engagement Hospital, Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS)

Survey Dimensions:

1. Communication with Nurses
2. Communication with Doctors
3. Responsiveness of Hospital Staff
4. Communication about Medicines

8. Overall Rating of Hospital

NQF-endorsed quality measure 2720

- Antibiotic use measure based on medication administration data collected by hospitals and reported electronically to CDC's National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN).
- NQF-endorsed December 2015 and is currently on CMS' Measure Under Consideration (MUC) list.
 - Numerator: Days of antimicrobial therapy for antibacterial agents administered to adult and pediatric patients in medical, medical/surgical, and surgical wards and medical, medical/surgical, and surgical intensive care units.
 - Denominator: Days present for each patient care defined as the number of patients who were present for any portion of each day of a calendar month for each location.
 - Applies to Hospital, Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility, Long Term Acute Care.

Exemptions due to Hurricane Harvey and Hurricane Irma

- CMS released a memo 9/7/17 granting exemptions to reporting under quality reporting and value-based purchasing programs for hospitals and other settings (ESRD, SNF, inpatient psychiatric facilities, home health agencies, PPS-exempt cancer hospitals, inpatient rehabilitation facilities) for facilities located in areas affected by Hurricane Harvey and Hurricane Irma.
- Applies to locations designated by FEMA as major disaster counties or parishes
- Directed resources toward patient care and repairing structural damage to facilities.
- CMS will closely monitor situation and update exemptions for these facilities in future communications.
